One day practical workshops with help given on an individual basis to develop the students' own ideas. The development of ideas through drawing will be encouraged and help then given to realise the idea in three-dimensions. Techniques will be demonstrated according to the needs of the students. Beginners will be given a set project to introduce the basic techniques of working with silver.
