ABOUT YOUR COURSE:

The students commence the course with a short talk on purchasing and conditioning suitable flowers. We start off by creating a basic design in a container. The students are then shown that these can be adapted into very individual arrangements.

In the afternoon we use an alternative but adaptable method.

Each student will be encouraged to design a table setting for a special occasion.

LEVEL: BEGINNERS/INTERMEDIATE

For those with little experience and for those who have taken a related course. Suited to those who would like a structured introduction to a subject, with further building of skills to work towards independent practise.

ABOUT YOUR TUTOR:

Sue Hingston is a professional florist who trained and worked in central London. She has taught at the international McQueens flower school and has led teams of florists to produce flowers for events in London, internationally and locally, including the events at West Dean.
