ABOUT YOUR COURSE:

This day will also give an insight into Janet's approach to making images and items with fabric and hand stitch. We will make a selection of individually designed, hand sewn, two-dimensional small hanging angels which could be used as Christmas tree decorations or attached to Christmas cards. Working directly with the fabrics, Janet will demonstrate the simple cutting, placing and hand sewing techniques needed.

Starting points. For those with little or no experience who want to go back to basics and would like a structured introduction to a subject.

Janet Bolton exhibits and teaches worldwide. She has work in public collections, including the Crafts Council and the British Council, and has published several books (for both adults and children) about her work and working practice.
