ABOUT YOUR COURSE:

Make a simple pair of enamelled drop earrings or a pendant in silver.

Following a short demonstration of basic enamelling techniques, you experiment with colours and designs to gain confidence with the technique. Then you decide on your own design to create either earrings or pendant.

Starting points. For those with little or no experience who want to go back to basics and would like a structured introduction to a subject.
