ABOUT YOUR COURSE:

On this course you will learn about the materials used for coloured pencil botanical work and the reasons why they are effective. You will learn the basic skill of laying down colour smoothly, mixing colours and choosing effective shade colours.

Ann will demonstrate the techniques of layering, embossing, burnishing and underpainting and give you clear guidance as you have a go yourselves. You will learn basic leaf techniques, how to mix realistic greens with some ways of achieving fine veins.

You will leave with some colour mixing templates and notes from the course plus a leaf study and a good idea of how to go about starting a botanical drawing in coloured pencil. Once you have completed this course you will be able to learn more on a longer course with Ann.

LEVEL: BEGINNERS

Starting points. For those with little or no experience who want to go back to basics and would like a structured introduction to a subject.

Ann is one of this country's leading botanical artists and teachers working primarily in coloured pencil and graphite.
