### ABOUT YOUR COURSE:

Learn pattern construction and adaptation to produce a pattern for a classic shift dress which fits you perfectly. After making a toile based on your own measurements, you construct and sew a dress in your chosen fabric, that has a great fit and a professional finish.

Some sewing experience is essential, you need to have experience of dressmaking, even though you may be new to cutting your own patterns.

**LEVEL:** INTERMEDIATE (i.e. Pattern cutting – beginners. Dressmaking – intermediate.) Skills development. For those who have taken a related course or have some existing skills. The focus is on further developing and building of skills working towards independent practice.

Maria Pulley trained at Kingston University. She runs her own made to measure business specialising in dresses for special occasions, tailoring and bridal wear.

For any materials you need to purchase from the shop, we suggest you do so during the first morning of your course, after having discussed with your tutor.
