ABOUT YOUR COURSE:

Pruning is such a vital element of gardening and once mastered is a skill that is a source of great satisfaction in the management of a garden.

This day-long course will outline the reasons behind different types of pruning on ornamental and productive plants and will provide students with the confidence to practice precise and accurate pruning across a broad selection of woody plants.

The course will illustrate how to prune for improved fruit and flower production, the maintenance of the ideal 'natural shape' in ornamental garden trees and shrubs and cover the basic techniques used to maintain plant health and vigour across a range of plants growing in different situations.

Classroom demonstrations, student practise on a variety of containerised plants and an afternoon garden tour highlighting the successful use of pruning by professionals at West Dean will each combine to provide students with the ability to tackle pruning with confidence by the end of the course.

LEVEL: BEGINNERS

Starting points. For those with little or no experience who want to go back to basics and would like a structured introduction to a subject.
