ABOUT YOUR COURSE:

This one-day workshop aims to provide students with the knowledge and skill to create two festive floral decorations. A traditional door wreath and a garland to festoon a staircase or mantle shelf. Although the students are using traditional methods they are taught to decorate the designs in a contemporary way.

You will come away having created two designs using fabulous winter foliage combined with other materials. This includes being shown how to use a variety of decorations to make them very individual.

The tutor will give group demonstrations of modern and traditional techniques and show you how to use a variety of decorations to make individual innovative designs. Individual help is given and review of the completed pieces is given at the end of the day.

LEVEL: BEGINNERS/INTERMEDIATE

For those with little or no experience and for those who have taken a related course. Suited to those who would like a structured introduction to a subject, with further building of skills to work towards independent practise.

ABOUT YOUR TUTOR:

Sue Hingston is a professional florist who trained and worked in central London. She has taught at the international McQueens Flower School. She has led teams of florists to produce flowers for events in London and internationally as well as locally which includes the events at West Dean.
