SID07905 PAINT WITH EGG TEMPERA - A TASTER DAY

Tutor: MAZ JACKSON

Dates: I DAY THURSDAY 31 MAY

ABOUT YOUR COURSE:

Complete a small painting following the traditions of egg tempera painting. After an introduction to egg tempera, you will learn correct proportions of egg yolk, water and pigment emulsions to build up a beautiful surface of underdrawing, glazing and various brushstrokes that make a true bond on a hand made gesso panel.

Group and individual tuition on drawing, composition and painting will be given throughout the day to bring your painting to fruition. Subject matter can be your own, abstract, or from a still life object. Pigments, palettes, brushes, studio equipment and a small hand-made gessoed panel are supplied.

By the end of the day you will have familiarised yourself with a paint medium that has the least restoration in history and that has been adapted by artists throughout the centuries to suit their practice.

LEVEL: BEGINNERS

Starting points. For those with little or no experience who want to go back to basics and would like a structured introduction to a subject.

ABOUT YOUR TUTOR:

Maz Jackson has been a practicing artist for 40 years, has won national and international awards and exhibits in galleries and museums worldwide. She has a deep interest in traditions of practice and enjoys translating imagery from her library of sketchbooks into egg tempera paintings and prints. As well as being a Short Course Tutor at West Dean for several years, Maz has given workshops and talks in schools, colleges and art societies. She has been a mentor for the Arts Council and worked as an advisor/practitioner with the BBC.

Materials included in the course fee:

The course fee includes the cost of providing materials shared amongst the group including earth, pigments, rigger brushes, sketching paper, distilled water and an A6 ($10 \times 15 \times 1$ cm) gessoed panel for each student. (The gessoed panel is hand made and comprised of a wooden panel, sized, wrapped in fine cotton and painted with 5 layers of hand made gesso.)
