ABOUT YOUR COURSE:

An inspiring day to launch you into acrylics! We begin this taster day with a talk on the basic principles of observation and use of colour. Discover the versatility of acrylic paint as you draw and paint from still life. We look at form, colour balance and brush handling. During the afternoon you complete your own acrylic painting.

We also look at the work of different artists and how colour, brushwork and paint itself can be handled. You will follow some simple demonstrations, supported with individual guidance. The day concludes with a brief discussion and encourages you to paint on.

LEVEL: BEGINNERS

Starting points. For those with little or no experience who want to go back to basics and would like a structured introduction to a subject.

Christine Forbes is a painter, illustrator and graduate of Northbrook College, Worthing. Her work is process based and guided by Chinese and Japanese philosophies.
