ABOUT YOUR COURSE:

Working with flowers with West Dean Gardens as an inspiration, the students create modern and stylish hand-tied bouquets and posies. You are advised how to select suitable flowers and foliage and how to look after and store them successfully. You will be taught two different methods and shown the versatility of the designs whether they be for gifts, vase arrangements or for a wedding.

LEVEL: BEGINNERS/INTERMEDIATE

For those with little or no experience and for those who have taken a related course. Suited to those who would like a structured introduction to a subject, with further building of skills to work towards independent practice.

ABOUT YOUR TUTOR:

Sue Hingston is a professional florist who trained and worked in central London. She has taught at the international McQueens Flower School and has led teams of florists to produce flowers for events in London, internationally and locally, including the events at West Dean.
