ABOUT YOUR COURSE:

This in depth Adobe Lightroom editing workshop is aimed at photographers with a basic knowledge of the software who would like to take their editing skills to a higher level. The workshop will concentrate mainly on the editing side of the develop module but will also cover workflow options within the software. The workshop will also explore the concepts of previsualization when shooting and the importance of assessing an image before editing. Using the West Dean gardens as subject matter we will be photographing for part of the workshop to produce the images for editing over the weekend.

LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE/ADVANCED

For those who have taken a related course or have some existing skills, and for more experienced practitioners who want to expand skills. The focus is on working towards independent practice.
