SID08300 PAINT A BOTANICAL CHRISTMAS CARD - A TASTER DAY

ABOUT YOUR COURSE:

Create a seasonal greetings card with a personal touch as you learn some of the processes involved in the exacting art of botanical painting. With the expert guidance of botanical artist Mariella Baldwin develop observational and watercolour painting techniques. The painting subjects will include seasonal material from the gardens at West Dean.

The course begins with an introduction to botanical painting and some demonstrations, you will then select your subject to draw and paint. You will be introduced to a step-by-step approach to painting, with demonstrations throughout as you learn colour mixing and matching, as well as dry brush and wet-in-wet application. Individual attention will be given during the course to help you develop your painting and skills so that you can make your chosen subject life-like using colour, form, tone and shade.

By the end of the day you will know more about botanical painting and how to paint a subject so that it looks like it could be plucked from the paper. You will have completed a small study which can be printed after the course for festive cards, photographed and used digitally, or simply be the inspiration to continue to enjoy painting.

LEVEL: BEGINNERS

Starting points. For those with little or no experience who want to go back to basics and would like a structured introduction to a subject.

Mariella Baldwin is a botanical illustrator and an experienced teacher. Her book 'Botanical Painting' was published in 2011. She exhibits her work in England and the USA. She has work in the Chelsea Physic Garden Archive.
