SID08366: MOSAIC MIRROR FRAME - A TASTER DAY

ABOUT YOUR COURSE:

Learn how to cut, arrange and fix ceramic and glass material to a square base to create a mosaic surround for a mirror. You will be encouraged to allow the materials selected to help inform your mosaic design by considering the arrangement of colour, surface quality and pattern, line and texture.

You will be provided with a square format mirror and larger board as your material starting point for designing and making a mirror with a mosaic surround to frame the mirror. You will be taught how to cut ceramic and glass mosaic tiles as well as select parts from decorative china that you might like to include. The tutor will discuss with you approaches to planning and constructing your mosaic and possible arrangements of materials to achieve your outcome. You will learn how to fix ceramic and glass material to the base. There will be a grouting demonstration for you to follow later when your mosaics are fully fixed. Grout will be available for you to take away. You will be encouraged to allow the materials selected to help inform your mosaic design by considering the arrangement of colour, surface quality and pattern, line and texture. Although there will be the potential to make your work festive in quality and flavour, it will primarily be the materials and the process that will be your inspiration, more than any suggested subject or pictorial references.

LEVEL: SUITABLE FOR ALL

A subject focused course that is delivered to suit any level of experience from beginner to advanced practitioner. A structured start is followed by guided independent practice.

You need to have enough strength in your hand to squeeze the tools to cut ceramic tiles and fragments.

ABOUT YOUR TUTOR:

Joanna Veevers trained in printed textiles followed by a ceramics MA from the RCA. Over the past 30 years, her career has involved making work to commission and for exhibitions, projects in education and part-time lecturing. Surfaces, 2D design, drawing, printing and making, are her primary preoccupations within her own practice and her teaching.
