SID08322: SILVER AUTUMN LEAF PENDANT

ABOUT YOUR COURSE:

On this one day course learn to make an elegant silver pendant using autumn leaves as an inspirational starting point. You will be using leaf skeletons to impress into sheet silver leaving the delicate tracery of the veins of the leaf as a surface pattern on the precious metal. You will then learn to saw pierce the shape of the leaf and file the edges smooth, and then to shape and polish it and finally to oxidise it to make the leaf vein pattern stand out clearly on the silver. This project is a basic introduction to some of the skills and processes of making jewellery in silver which will inspire you to want to learn more about this fascinating discipline.

LEVEL: BEGINNERS

Starting points. For those with little or no experience who want to go back to basics and would like a structured introduction to a subject. You do need to have good eyesight for this project or have magnifying glasses enabling you to focus close up.
