SID08617: TERRARIUM, KOKEDAMA AND MACRAMÉ PLANT HANGER – HOUSE PLANT STYLING WORKSHOP

ABOUT YOUR COURSE:

Jen will show how to bring the beauty of an outdoor garden indoors. She will begin by demonstrating how to make an open terrarium, hanging Kokedama and macramé plant hanger.

The day will begin with a short talk about the history of the terrariums and choosing the right plant, soil and container. Jen will give a practical demonstration then you will make your own terrarium using five different varieties of succulents. She will also demonstrate how to make a Kokedama (Japanese hanging moss ball – planted with a house plant). The afternoon will be spent making a macramé plant hanger.

LEVEL: BEGINNERS/INTERMEDIATE

For those with little or no experience and for those who have taken a related course. Suited to those who would like a structured introduction to a subject, with further building of skills to work towards independent practice.

ABOUT YOUR TUTOR:

Jen Berry is a garden designer who has a background in fashion design. She is based near St Albans and has her own garden design and planting business. She runs workshops in making terrariums and Kokedama along with various aspects of house plant styling.
