Those intrigued by the bobbin lacemaking have an opportunity to sample the techniques which form the foundation of this ancient textile skill. Using the pre-prepared bobbins wound with lacemaking thread and equipment supplied for use on the day, you will learn how to set-up and make the basic stitches to create a small decorative piece.

The tutor will also advise on the next steps and best places to purchase equipment if you decide you would like to continue.

LEVEL: BEGINNERS

Starting points. For those with little or no experience who want to go back to basics and would like a structured introduction to a subject.

Come along with an open mind and have an interesting, informative and productive day, taking home your own piece of handmade bobbin lace.
