Describe, in a different way to yesterday, another character. Someone that yesterday's person may come into relationship with. You may describe them according to how they look, OR something you see them do OR something you have heard about them OR by relating an anecdote about them and yesterday's character (how they met, something they did etc)

Next. Regardless of who your second character is write 250 words about something good they did for someone Or bad they did TO someone. Preferably something secret.

Finally (how did we get here already?) a wee bit of dialogue. You have two characters. Choose one of the following first lines, said by character B to character A and write up to 10 lines of dialogue leading on from it.

- a) I caught your cold...
- b) I don't believe you...
- c) I'm no happier than you are about it...
- d) No I didn't...

Things to think about.

It can take a while to get a rhythm going with dialogue, don't worry about that, just go with it and let it emerge.

People do not speak the way they write.
