## Edward James Foundation Bursaries

Candidates who have accepted their place on a Diploma or Degree Programme and paid their deposit can apply for a bursary from the Edward James Foundation. The Foundation grants bursaries for people who have a financial need. Grants will be awarded towards a portion of the tuition fees, but not usually for accommodation fees or living expenses.
